## Pastor's Message

Brothers & Sisters,

As we all know, during the season of Lent the Church asks us to pray, fast, and give alms. Charitable giving is a very ancient practice; almsgiving was common long before the time of Jesus. The Lenten call to almsgiving means making the needs of other people our own. One of the central lessons of the cross is compassion; sharing our material goods is often just the beginning of real Christian giving.

Here in our parish, we are making good progress toward our goal of \$ 34,175 For the Diocesan Development Drive. We have raised \$14,398 so far. The rebate that returns to our parish, after we hit our goal, will be used to make needed repairs to our parking lot. So the money we all give not only supports other parishes in need and programs throughout the Diocese, it does come back to us and help us meet our needs as well. Please, consider joining me in making a contribution to support these efforts.

Our Hispanic Community invites everyone to bring their appetite next Sunday, March 27th. After the 11 am & 12:30 pm Masses they will be selling smothered burritos in the Parish Hall. \$8 for the meal including a beverage, the proceeds will be donated to the parish. We thank them for the food and you for supporting their ministry.

This weekend, those in our RCIA program will celebrate the First Scrutiny. The "Scrutinies of the Elect" takes place during the three Sundays before Palm Sunday. Scrutiny is a word that means "to search". The scrutinies are meant to uncover, then heal all that is weak in the hearts of the elect; to bring out, then strengthen all that is strong, and good. The scrutinies are celebrated in order to protect them against temptation and to give them strength in Christ. These rites should complete the conversion of the elect and deepen their resolve. During the First Scrutiny, the Elect have hands laid upon them and are prayed over and pray that they may reject everything in their lives that is contrary to Christ. Let us pray for all those who are preparing to enter our community and to find inspiration in their journey.

In the near future, you may notice large construction materials and equipment on the previously unused portion of our parish grounds near I-215. Newman Construction is leasing our land for the next 6 months as a staging area for their project with Taylorsville Bennion which will take place on 2200 W and 5400S. Our agreement with them ensures that they will have no impact on our weekend mass schedule and very little if any impact during the week. Let us respect them and their work as they have promised to respect us and our worship.

Como todos sabemos, durante el tiempo de Cuaresma la Iglesia nos pide orar, ayunar y dar limosna.
