Pastor's Message

Brothers & Sisters,

We hear about the man born blind in today's Gospel. We can be blind ourselves to our own sins and to the needs of others. But Jesus can take away our blindness if we only have faith in him, follow his ways and ask him to do so. Jesus is the light of the world and can break through our blindness if only we let him.

This weekend those in our RCIA program continue their faith journey with the second Scrutiny. They continue to search their consciences for sinful thoughts and actions. The Scrutinies are meant to uncover and then heal what is weak within us. They are meant to strengthen all that is good and to provide protection against temptations and sin. Even if these rites are not celebrated at the liturgy we attend, it is good for us to reflect upon the journey these Elect are making during Lent, as an inspiration and source of renewal for us in our journey.

The 4th Sunday of Lent is called "Laetare Sunday" and marks the halfway point of Lent. All that beautiful prayer, fasting, and almsgiving - you are halfway through keeping your commitments! Or, you need to redouble your efforts. "Rejoice, O Jerusalem!" because this is a day of joy! We are so close to Easter and Jesus' Resurrection.

On April 6th we will be having a Lenten Penance service in the church at 7 pm. There will be a brief prayer service and reflection followed by the opportunity for individual confessions in English and Spanish. I have invited some other priests to assist at this event, please join us.
