Pastor's Message

Brothers and Sisters,

Hosanna! Hosanna! Hosanna in the highest!

This Sunday we enter Holy Week. In the readings, Jesus enters Jerusalem and enters triumphal. He knows what lies ahead, and yet He continues. He continues with the love, the passion, which gives us hope, which inspires awe, and which exemplifies love in and for us.

The celebrations of Holy Week are some of the most important and beautiful liturgies in our year. If you have not been to them before, I invite you to come and experience these richly meaningful celebrations.

At the Mass of the Lord's Supper on Thursday at 7 pm we recall the institution of the Eucharist and commemorate the institution of the priesthood. On the night of Holy Thursday, Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament takes place until Midnight, the faithful remain in the presence of the Eucharist just as the Disciples kept a vigil with Christ.

Good Friday is the day on which Catholics commemorate the crucifixion of Jesus Christ. The events of Good Friday are remembered as we pray the Stations of the Cross at 3 pm in the church & 5 pm outside with our Spanish community and the "Living Stations". At 7 pm in the church, we will celebrate the liturgy of the Passion of the Lord.

From the darkness, we emerge on Saturday evening at 8:30 pm with celebration of the Easter Vigil Mass. Our RCIA candidates will be baptized and confirmed, a new Pascal candle will be blessed, and we will celebrate the joy of the Resurrection with word and song.

As with all events in our parish, there are countless people at work behind the scenes making sure everything is taken care of, the church will be decorated, the music practiced, the readings prepared, the windows cleaned, the floors mopped, and vacuumed. To all of the many hands, seen and unseen, I thank you for your dedication to our parish community. I simply could not do this without you!

Mensaje del párroco

Hermanos y hermanas,

¡Hosana! ¡Hosana! ¡Hosanna en lo más alto!

Este domingo entramos en Semana Santa. En las lecturas, Jesús entra en Jerusalén y entra triunfal. Él sabe lo que está por delante y, sin embargo, continúa. Continúa con el amor, la pasión, que nos da esperanza, que inspira asombro y que ejemplifica el amor en y por nosotros.

Las celebraciones de la Semana Santa son algunas de las liturgias más importantes y hermosas de nuestro año. Si no ha estado en ellas antes, lo invito a que venga y experimente estas celebraciones ricas en significado.

En la Misa de la Cena del Señor del jueves a las 19 horas recordamos la institución de la Eucaristía y conmemoramos la institución del sacerdocio. En la noche del Jueves Santo se realiza la Adoración al Santísimo Sacramento hasta la Medianoche, los fieles permanecen en presencia de la Eucaristía así como los Discípulos velaban con Cristo.

El Viernes Santo es el día en que los católicos conmemoran la crucifixión de Jesucristo. Los eventos del Viernes Santo son recordados mientras rezamos las Estaciones de la Cruz a las 3 pm en la iglesia ya las 5 pm afuera con nuestra comunidad hispana y las “Estaciones Vivas”. A las 7 pm en la iglesia, celebraremos la liturgia de la Pasión del Señor.

De la oscuridad, salimos el sábado por la noche a las 8:30 p. m. con la celebración de la Misa de la Vigilia Pascual. Nuestros candidatos de RICA serán bautizados y confirmados, se bendecirá un nuevo cirio pascual y celebraremos la alegría de la Resurrección con la palabra y canción

Al igual que con todos los eventos en nuestra parroquia, hay innumerables personas trabajando detrás de escena para asegurarse de que todo esté bien cuidado: la iglesia estará decorada, se practicará la música, se prepararon las lecturas, se limpiarán las ventanas, se trapearán los pisos y se pasará la aspiradora. A todas las muchas manos, visibles e invisibles, les agradezco su dedicación a nuestra comunidad parroquial. ¡Simplemente no podría hacer esto sin ti!
